**EVENING DINNER CRUISE** Enjoy a superb meal whilst cruising along the Chao Phraya River with views of Wat Arun, the 'Temple of Dawn' and Grand Palace by night. Nightly from 18:30-22:00. Price £27 per person.

**THAI DINNER & CLASSICAL DANCE** This evening introduces you to mystical dances, delicious Thai cuisine and a true Thai ambience. Nightly from 19:30 - 22:30. Price £13 per person.

**THREE TOUR PACKAGE** A great value for money option, incorporating 3 of the most popular Bangkok tours. A half day Bangkok city & temples tour, a half day Grand Palace Tour and a full day tour to the floating markets and the Rose Garden Thai Village. Daily from 08:00. Price from £53 per person.

**RIVER KWAI & TIGER TEMPLE** Visit the site of the famous "Bridge over the River Kwai" see the Allied War cemetery & take a ride on the notorious Death Railway. Then visit Tiger Temple (Wat Pa Luang Ta Bua Yansampanno Forest Monastery). Departs every Mon/Wed & Fri. Price £46 per person.
