ESSENTIAL EXPERIENCES

KOH LAN Just 7.5km off the coast of Pattaya, this small island has beautiful beaches and colourful corals teeming with fish which can be viewed from glass bottom boats. It's also a great spot for watersports, offering windsurfing, waterskiing and parasailing. Daily 09:00-16:30. Price £13 per person.

ELEPHANT VILLAGE This half day tour will give you the opportunity to see trained elephants demonstrating their time-honoured forestry skills, enjoying themselves playing football, and be entertained by the frolics of both young and old as they take their daily bath. Daily 13:30-16:30. Price £13 per person.

PARADISE ISLAND Slightly further away from Pattaya is Koh Samet, otherwise known as Paradise Island, just 11 miles east from Rayong Province. This full day excursion gives you the opportunity to get away from Pattaya and experience the more peaceful and beautiful island life. Lunch is included. Daily 09:00-16:30. Price £20 per person.

ALCAZAR OR TIFFANY CABARET SHOW is a live show of professional transvestite entertainers presenting artistic impersonations through song and tales of love and adventure, accompanied by a fantastic sound and light show. Nightly 18:30, 20:00 or 21:30. Price £14 per person.

NONG NOOCH VILLAGE & SHOW Nong Nooch is an extensive botanical garden with orchards and parkland. There will you see displays of Thai dancing, Thai boxing, an elephant show, plus much more. Daily 08:30-13:30 & 13:30-17:30. Price £14 per person.
