ESSENTIAL Information

VISA

British passport holders do not require a visa to enter Mauritius. Visitors require a passport valid for more than 6 months from the date of arrival, onward tickets, proof of accommodation and sufficient funds for the duration of the stay.

CURRENCY

The local currency is Mauritian Rupee.

HEALTH

A valid yellow fever vaccination certificate is required for all travellers over one year of age who have passed through a partly or wholly infected area within the preceding 6 days. Make sure your vaccinations are up to date. It is always advisable to check with the Foreign Office and the Department of Health for updates prior to your travel. We always recommend you purchase Travel Insurance.

Mauritius is approximately 11 hours and 55 minutes by non-stop flight from the UK.
