

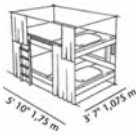
Our Freedom of the Rails program is the base for creating unique, independent touring packages or for presenting modular independent services. VIA gives stress-free travel a whole new meaning. The VIA experience begins with stations that are easy to access, boarding procedures that are simple and hassle-free, and comfortable, spacious trains with lots of room for carry-on luggage. With their downtown-to-downtown services, convenient departures and competitive travel times, you can count on VIA to get you to your destination rested and relaxed. A document package including local information, schedules, tickets and vouchers is provided at your first hotel.



### VIA Rail Accommodation

On VIA Rail sleeping cars, passengers enjoy a reserved seating area for daytime travel, which is made into sleeping berths by an attendant in the evening. A shower room and toilet facilities are located in each car in trans-continental cars only. Three types of accommodation are offered.

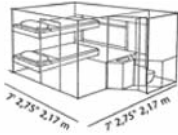
**Berth Class/Section (Upper/Lower) (Canadian and Chaleur only)** offers deep-cushioned seats with an optional table by day that converts to upper and lower beds with privacy curtain at night. Toilet and shower facilities are shared. Complimentary shower kits including soap, shampoo, cap, towel and washcloth.



**Roomette (Canadian and Chaleur only)/Single Bedroom (Ocean only)** is a small private room with a sink, toilet facilities and air conditioning. Access to shared showers with complimentary shower kits containing soap, shampoo, cap, towel and washcloth. The room accommodates one adult in a single bed and two can sit together at least part of the time during the day if desired. Two people travelling together in roomettes are usually located adjacent to each other.



**Bedroom (Canadian and Chaleur only)/Double/Deluxe Double Bedroom (Ocean only)** is a private room for two people with toilet facilities and air conditioning. The room contains comfortable armchairs in the daytime, which convert to upper and lower beds at night. There is a small closet (holds 1 large and 1 small suitcase), reading lamp and a sink with razor outlet. Access to a shower room, just a few steps away, with a complimentary shower kit containing soap, shampoo, cap, towel and washcloth.



Additional amenities on the "Renaissance" Cars (The Ocean Train): room service call phone, individual hot water dispenser (for coffee or tea service), clothes valet, an intercom system, an emergency window, a card entry lock, larger beds, peep-hole on door, smoke and fire detector, emergency push-button alarm located in washroom. Each car contains 10 bedrooms; 6 deluxe cabins with private shower and 4 standard cabins without shower. Showers are not available in the car.

**Important Notes:**  
 Infants: Under the age of 2, travelling with an adult, travel free of charge, provided they do not occupy a seat. There must be at least one adult per room for the child rate to apply. Discount fares apply to children and seniors (60+) and are noted with each product. Customers are requested to limit baggage to two pieces of carry on baggage, maximum weight of 50lbs.  
 There is no smoking on any VIA trains system wide. Smoking is only permitted in designated areas at some stations. Schedules are for information purpose only and are subject to change.  
 If you have purchased your rail ticket in conjunction with other ground arrangements your Via Rail vouchers and documentation will be available for pick-up at your first hotel. Special cancellation policy applies, please ask for details.

### Via Rail Corridor

VIA Rail is an excellent way to travel along the central Canadian Corridor with downtown to downtown links between some of eastern Canada's main cities from Quebec City to Windsor. VIA's LRC trains are truly comfortable and travel rapidly at speeds of up to 177 km per hour through the glorious Canadian countryside. Enjoy the extra benefits that VIA 1 offers, including seat selection at time of booking, VIA 1 Panorama Lounges, pre-boarding privileges and a selection of complimentary daily newspapers. Unwind with an aperitif before enjoying a choice of main entrees, wine with your meal and coffee with liqueur (offered on evening trains).

### The Skeena

The Skeena between Jasper, Prince George and Prince Rupert is your picture window on the spectacular mountain scenery of Alberta and northern British Columbia. This two-day daylight journey from the resort town of Jasper through the Yellowhead Pass stops overnight in Prince George (accommodation not included) and continues on to the Pacific coastal city of Prince Rupert the following day. From May to September VIA Rail also offers the Totem Class Deluxe and Totem Class service onboard Skeena. The Totem Deluxe Class includes seats in a fully glass-enclosed dome for 360-degree viewing and added comfort and style. Totem Deluxe includes continental breakfast, lunch and dinner with wine as well as use of the comfortable Bullet Lounge. Comfort class features cart service year round. Meals are not included.
